

栾树属 - Koelreuteria, Golden Rain Tree (Sapindaceae)



栾树 - paniculata

Origin: China, Korea. Small deciduous tree which is admired for the elegant foliage, beautiful flowers and unusual fruit. Imparipinnate leaves, up to 40cm long, made up of numerous bright green leaflets; beautiful yellow and orange colours in autumn. Flowers in June-July, bright yellow, small and grouped in upright panicles 20-30cm long. Fruit: after flowering, similar to Chinese lanterns, initially green and then pink. No particular requirements as regards soil, also grows in calcareous soil.

paniculata "Fastigiata"

Fastigiate selection of the type, with identical foliage, flowers, fruits and growing requirements. Used in parks, medium-sized gardens and wide avenues.
